GENERAL NOTES

In case of sealing or maintenance work the relevant standards and guidelines must be followed.

SUBSTRATE PREPARATION

• The substrate must be sufficiently dry, level, stable, frost-protected, clean and without traces of oil, grease, tar, honeycombing, cracks, dust, dirt, residue mortar or other potential contaminants.

^{*} The consumption rates shown are minimum values. These may increase according to the manner of application.

^{**} These times may vary greatly, depending on humidity, temperature, coating thickness and substrate. Times are based on the standard climate of + 23 °C and 50 % relative humidity.





APPLICATION

- · Rasco Bitumen Cold Adhesive is ready-to-use and can be applied with a roofing brush or roll in the necessary coat thickness extensively onto the cleaned surface.
- · Roll the membrane extensively onto Rasco Bitumen Cold Adhesive after approx. 10-15 min. curing time taking care to avoid bubbles and creases.
- · Press on soundly until adhesive oozes out through joints.
- · Overlap next membrane by about 10 cm.
- · Spread out surplus material at the joints with a trowel or brush.
- Depending on the substrates it may be necessary to weigh down newly laid down membranes to avoid curling at the corners.

SPECIAL NOTES

- · Protect the newly applied material from rain, frost and strong sun light until completely dry.
